
Tips from the Lock Shop

Swapping key cylinders from one lock to another can be a common task for many facility lock techs. A common complaint is that the threads have been damaged or the factories lock tite make removing the cylinders very difficult. After receiving many requests for a tool to make removing the cylinders easier we here at Western Detention produced a cylinder specific wrench.

The WDPI cylinder nut wrench makes removing cylinders a breeze. No more using a chisel or screwdriver to slowly tap the ring loose (usually further damaging the threads). Now simply remove the covers off the locks and pop the ring loose with a nice ergonomic wrench. We hope this tip will help you Let us know if you have an easier way and we will be sure to pass your tips on to other customers. Always remember to keep an eye out for foreign materials lodged in any parts of your detention hardware including; slider tracks, lock strikes, etc. We do offer full repairs on any of your Folger Adam or Southern Steel hardware if any problems arise.
